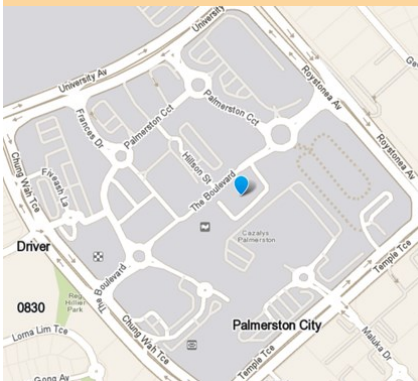

He currently holds waterwell licences in four states, Cert 3 in Water Industry Operations, Cert 4 in Workplace Training and Assessing, and an Advanced Diploma of Drilling Management. Allen is a registered assessor with the ADITC.

Mark has been in Waterwell drilling for over 32 years. He has worked throughout the NT and drilled a wide variety of bores for remote coastal communities, large horticulture developments and town supplies including the drilling and rehabilitation of artesian bores.

Mark is the Drilling Manager for Water Resources in the NT and as a member of the NUDLC assisted with the 3rd edition of the MCRWBA .

This course includes practical experience. Content aligns to components of the National Water-well Drillers Licence Examinations for Classes 1, 2 and 3, but the requirement to cement grout holes applies to many sectors of drilling. It covers:

- Occupational Health & Safety with regard to grouting operations
- Equipment, materials and additives used for grouting operations
- Grouting techniques and procedures
- Maths and calculations required to successfully plan and complete grouting operations
- Properties of grouting fluids and additives
- Use of grouting in bore design and bore construction, and bore decommissioning
- National minimum bore construction requirements in regard to grout use and standards
